

## 2019 Houston Trip FAQs

### 1. What will the weather be like in Houston, and what kinds of clothing should I pack?

The average temperatures in Houston for this time of year are 75-85 degrees for the high and 55-65 degrees for the low. Intermittent light rain showers are not completely uncommon for Houston at this time of the year. Be sure to bring a light jacket and a small collapsible umbrella if you have one. Please refer to the internet for up-to-date weather forecasts prior to packing.

### 2. Will I need to bring my all-black formal concert attire?

Yes. All trip participant performers will need to wear their all-black concert attire for the performance once we arrive in Houston on the first day of the trip. Students should plan to bring their all-black concert attire with them to their seat on the bus, packing it within their bus "carry-on" bag.

### 3. How much money should I bring for food and souvenirs?

Breakfast at the hotel each morning is included in the trip cost. In addition, you will receive one Schlitterbahn lunch meal voucher and one Space Center lunch meal voucher. Dinner at the Buca di Beppo and the Lighthouse Buffet is also included within the trip cost. The only meals not included within the trip cost are Saturday's breakfast on the way to San Antonio, Saturday's lunch at the Galleria, Sunday's dinner at Schlitterbahn, and Tuesday's lunch on the way home. Both of those meals will be on your own at fast food restaurants. Also, please plan on bringing a little extra money for between meal snacks and souvenirs.

### 4. Can I keep my prescription medication, over-the-counter medication, and/or inhaler with me, or do I need to turn it in?

Please refer to the included *Medication Form* for details as to the MISD policy for both prescription and over-the-counter medications and their distribution while on campus or on a school related trip. Specific information regarding the use of inhalers is also included on this document. We will be strictly adhering to the guidelines as they are outlined in this document throughout the duration of our trip.

### 5. What are the luggage and bus "carry-on" bag guidelines for the trip?

Each person is allowed one piece of luggage to be placed underneath the bus. Each person is also allowed one bus "carry-on" bag of typical backpack-sized dimensions.

The following instruments should be placed underneath the bus: Bass Clarinet, Saxophone, Trumpet, French Horn, Trombone, Euphonium, and Tuba

The following instruments should be stored inside the bus above your seat: Piccolo, Flute, Oboe, Bassoon, and Clarinet

### 6. How are we traveling to and from our activities during the trip?

We will be transported to and from all activities while on the trip via charter bus. Attendance will be taken prior to each departure.

### 7. Do I need to be academically eligible in order to participate on the trip?

Yes, as stated in the original trip information, all students must be academically eligible in order to participate on the trip.

8. How can my parents get in touch with me while I'm in Houston?

If you have a cell phone of your own, bring it and a charger. Cell phones are the best way for your parents to reach you. They can also contact the hotel at the following number: **832-803-1234**

9. Who do I contact if I have a question about something or need help?

We have roughly a 6:1 student to chaperone ratio on the trip. MISD recommends a 20:1 student to chaperone ratio for high school groups. We are well within the MISD guidelines.

Our chaperones will serve as the first contact person if you need assistance with something. Each chaperone will be assigned several students to monitor and check-in with on a regular basis including morning and evening resort room checks. Each chaperone will closely monitor their designated student group and be on hand if the need for assistance should arise. The chaperones will be in constant contact with the directors at all times. Chaperones will exchange cell phone numbers with each of the students whom they are monitoring.

10. Is it a good idea for me to wander off by myself while on any portion of this trip?

Absolutely no one should wander off by themselves at anytime on this trip. It is always safer to travel in larger groups than smaller ones, so please use common sense and travel in groups of at least three.

11. How will I check-in with my designated chaperone throughout the day on the trip?

According to the itinerary, students will be in small, chaperoned groups or will be required to check-in visually with their designated chaperone at a designated location at specific times of the day while we are at Schlitterbahn. In order to help the students remember to check-in promptly, automatic reminder texts will be sent to each student's cell phone from our Remind class just prior to each of the check-in times.

12. Will we have access to the hotel pool or fitness center?

No, the hotel pool and fitness center will be off-limits to us during the trip.

13. If there is one thing that will make this trip fun and successful for everyone involved, what would that one thing be?

**Be where you are supposed to be, when you are supposed to be there!** Punctuality is of the utmost importance on any group trip. Many other people are depending upon you to be on time all of the time. This is not an issue for which the directors or chaperones will have any tolerance. Plan to be early.

14. I've packed everything I think I'll need, but I feel as though I've forgotten something. What might that be?

Did you remember to pack your all-black concert attire within your bus "carry-on" bag? Did you pack your cell phone charger? Have you turned in your **medication form**? Do you have any prescription and/or over-the-counter **medications** that you need to turn-in? Did you remember to pack sunscreen? Did you pack DVDs for the bus trips (rated G, PG, or PG-13 only)?

# Lake Ridge Band Trip 2019 Medication Form

### Medication Administration

School personnel may administer medication when such treatment is necessary for school attendance and cannot otherwise be accomplished. This completed form along with the medication and/or special equipment items are brought to the school by the parent.

- The medication must be brought to school in original, properly labeled containers. The pharmacy can supply two (2) labeled bottles for this purpose. Medication sent in baggies will not be administered.
- **Medications will not be given without a specific written request signed by at least one parent or legal guardian.**
- All medications must be kept with a designated director or school personnel, *except for students whose doctor requires them to carry medication (such as inhalers) on their person.* An additional prescription of the medication must be kept with the designated director or school personnel in charge of administering medication. If a student allows another person to use their medication, the privilege will be revoked.
- Over-the-counter medications require a parent signature and that the medication has been given before with no known allergies. The medication can only be given as directed by the manufacture and must be **FDA approved.**
